# Culture

The way of life of a group of people.



***Example:*** When we study a culture we study things such as beliefs, customs, and traditions.

# Culture Trait

The food, clothing, technology, beliefs, language, and tools that the people of a culture share.



***Example:*** Wearing blue jeans to school is a culture trait of the children who attend public school in America.

# Culture Group

People who share similar culture traits are members of the same culture group.



**Example:** American teenagers form a culture group because they share similar tastes in music, clothing, and sport.

# Transportation Corridor

Paths that make transportation easier.



***Example:*** Rivers and coastal waters, sometimes combined with human-made canals and locks, provide convenient transportation corridors.

# Migration

The process of relocating to a new region.



**Example:** From earliest times, people have moved, or migrated, to new locations.

# Pull Factor

The reasons that attract people to another area.



***Example:*** Pull factors, such as better jobs, often attract people to the cities.

# Transportation Barrier

Geographic features that prevent or slow down transportation.



***Example:*** Snow, ice and mountains are transportation barriers.



# Push Factor

The reasons that cause people to leave an area.



***Example:*** Push factors, such as crop failure, give a group of people a reason for moving.
